Dear Competitor:

Welcome to the 2016 Tennessee Valley 120 Field Target Championship! We would like to welcome you to this year's match. We have planned a challenging and enjoyable weekend for you and we are happy that you are able to shoot with us. Enclosed in this registration package (and on the GOB website) you will find match information and a map of the Pulaski Tennessee area.

This match will follow AAFTA rules and will qualify as an AAFTA Grand Prix match. We at the Good Ole' Boys club decided to hold this match after the unfortunate cancellation of the April Grand Prix match in Heflin. We are planning a great match with challenging courses but basic food and awards.

If you plan to fly to the match you can fly into Nashville Regional Airport or Huntsville Regional Airport. The Nashville Airport is about 85 miles from Pulaski, from the airport drive to I-65 south to exit 22, go south (right) on SR31A to SR31 south. Go south on SR31 to SR116 (College) west to the hotel. The Huntsville Airport is about 40 miles from Pulaski, from the airport go west on I565 to I65 north. Go to exit 1, SR31 and go north west (left) about 15 miles to SR116 (College) then west to the hotel.

To get to the match, go east on SR116 to SR31 south. Go south about 8 miles to Hardy Road. Turn east (left) on Hardy for 1 mile to Roz Sumpters driveway on the right and come on in.

There will be a covered area at the match where a swap area can be setup so bring what you would like to sell or trade. Please plan to bring your own water and seating to the match.

We are planning to have a challenging and safe match but to be successful we will need your help. Here are a few things we would like to remind you of to help make this match go smoothly.

- Be safe, keep your gun pointed down range and away from other at all times. Be careful when handling your rifle so that you don't point it at others.
- Please be ready to shoot when it is your turn.
- When it is your turn to shoot, please keep your conversation to a minimum.
- To help complete the match in a timely manner, a 7 minute time limit will be imposed on all shooters. The time limit will begin at the time the shooter takes position on the lane (bum on bag or proper addressing of the lane on standing/kneelin).
- Target malfunctions will be handled according to the guidelines detailed in the AAFTA Handbook.
- All ties will be broken with a shoot off.
